SOPREMA has taken a majority stake in Termo Organika

Founded in Strasbourg in 1908, **SOPREMA** is a worldwide specialist in waterproofing and thermal insulation for buildings and civil engineering. The **SOPREMA** Group generated a revenue of **€2.75 billion** in 2018, and has 67 production facilities in Europe, North America and Asia.

TERMO ORGANIKA was established in 1997 in Mielec, Poland, and is the country's largest manufacturer of expanded polystyrene boards. The company currently has four EPS plants, in Mielec, Głogów, Siedlce, and Rypin, and a building chemistry production plant in Pyrzycy. An extensive network of sales representatives provides coverage across the entire country.

TERMO ORGANIKA manufactures guaranteed high-quality insulation materials: dotted expanded polystyrene (EPS) boards (with exclusivity rights) and top performance grey EPS boards with the composite that enhances the insulation properties of the product. Ever since its inception, **TERMO ORGANIKA** has placed a special emphasis on product quality, with its qualified, professionally trained staff developing products to the highest international standards. **TERMO ORGANIKA** generated revenues of €82 million in 2018. Termo Organika is the market leader in the EPS thermal insulation for the building industry in Poland.

This acquisition further strengthens **SOPREMA**'s ongoing Strategic Initiative to develop its positions in Central and Eastern Europe, and more particularly in Poland, where **SOPREMA** has already made strategic investments: in 2010, **SOPREMA** built a brand-new, state-of-the-art factory dedicated to waterproofing systems and bitumen roll production in Błonie, near Warsaw.

SOPREMA provides best-in-class solid and liquid waterproofing systems for all types of building and infrastructure projects in Poland, with flourishing sales of its systems for use in demanding and prestigious projects all over the country. **SOPREMA** also exports products from its Polish facility to several other countries, including Sweden, Finland, Romania, Hungary, and China.

TERMO ORGANIKA's current Executive Management Team will remain shareholders and will continue to be fully in charge of developing **TERMO ORGANIKA**. Future plans include leveraging the products and systems portfolio, as well as developing synergies with the **SOPREMA** network of companies to offer additional solutions to customers in Poland and neighbouring countries.
